Initial unemployment insurance claims rise for week ending November 11

BATON ROUGE, LA – The initial unemployment insurance claims for the week ending November 11, 2023, rose to 1,833 from the week ending November 4, 2023, a total of 1,782. For a comparison, during the week ending November 12, 2022, 1,549 initial claims were filed.

The four-week moving average of initial claims increased to 1,728 from the previous week's average of 1,645.

The unemployment insurance continued claims for the week ending November 11, 2023, increased to 12,588 from the week ending November 4, 2023, a total of 12,403. The continued claims were above the comparable figure of 10,313 for the week ending November 12, 2022.

The four-week moving average of continued claims increased to 12,062 from the previous week's average of 11,982.
