## Initial unemployment insurance claims drop for week ending February 10

**BATON ROUGE, LA** – The initial unemployment insurance claims for the week ending February 10, 2024, dropped to 1,541 from the week ending February 3, 2024, a total of 1,585. For a comparison, during the week ending February 11, 2023, 1,766 initial claims were filed.

The four-week moving average of initial claims decreased to 1,510 from the previous week's average of 1,568.

The unemployment insurance continued claims for the week ending February 10, 2024, increased to 12,237 from the week ending February 3, 2024, a total of 12,212. The continued claims were below the comparable figure of 12,296 for the week ending February 11, 2023.

The four-week moving average of continued claims decreased to 12,422 from the previous week's average of 12,706.
