Initial unemployment insurance claims drop for week ending March 23

BATON ROUGE, LA – The initial unemployment insurance claims for the week ending March 23, 2024, dropped to 1,512 from the week ending March 16, 2024, a total of 1,519. For a comparison, during the week ending March 25, 2023, 1,562 initial claims were filed.

The four-week moving average of initial claims increased to 1,554 from the previous week's average of 1,532.

The unemployment insurance continued claims for the week ending March 23, 2024, increased to 11,056 from the week ending March 16, 2024, a total of 11,049. The continued claims were below the comparable figure of 11,190 for the week ending March 25, 2023.

The four-week moving average of continued claims decreased to 11,153 from the previous week's average of 11,301.
