## Initial unemployment insurance claims drop for week ending June 15

**BATON ROUGE, LA** – The initial unemployment insurance claims for the week ending June 15, 2024, dropped to 2,020 from the week ending June 8, 2024, totaling 2,193. For a comparison, during the week ending June 17, 2023, 2,202 initial claims were filed.

The four-week moving average of initial claims increased to 2,111 from the previous week's average of 2,095.

The unemployment insurance continued weeks claimed for the week ending June 15, 2024, increased to 13,705 from the week ending June 8, 2024, totaling 13,030. The continued weeks claimed were below the comparable figure of 14,167 for the week ending June 17, 2023.

The four-week moving average of continued weeks claimed increased to 12,636 from the previous week's average of 12,066.
