+ §101 (b) (1) (C) (i): Within the state board... “a majority shall be representatives of business.”

++ §101 (b) (1) (C) (ii) (I): Within the state board... “not less than 20 percent shall be representatives of the workforce within the State, who shall include representatives of labor organizations, who have been nominated by State labor federations.”
